Try these fun activities at home with your child:

Number game

Use three dice. If you have only one dice, roll it 3 times.

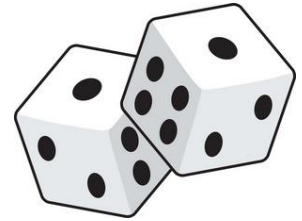
Make three-digit numbers, e.g. if you roll 2, 4 and 6, you could make 246, 264, 426, 462, 624 and 642.

Ask your child to round the three-digit number to the nearest multiple of 10.

Check whether it is correct, e.g. 76 to the nearest multiple of 10 is 80.

134 to the nearest multiple of 10 is 130. (A number ending in a 5 always rounds up.)

Roll again. This time round three-digit numbers to the nearest 100



Guess my shape

◆ Think of a 3-D shape

Ask your child to ask questions to try and guess what it is.

◆ You can only answer Yes or No.

For example, your child could ask: Does it have 3 corners or: Are its sides straight?

◆ See if he can guess your shape using fewer than five questions.

◆ Now ask them to choose a shape so you can ask questions.
