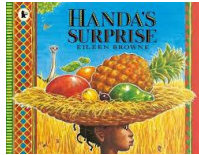

Key Areas of learning

As **Artists and Designers**, we will be using our skills to make various winter themed craft items and we will be making a fruit kebab linked to writing instructions in English.

Trips/Enrichment: puppet show

ENGLISH

Children will be:

- getting to know the story of 'Handa's Surprise by Eileen Browne and using it to create their own stories
- revisiting the features of **instructions** and using the features to write instructions for how to make a fruit kebab
- joining in with **rhymes and poems**; comparing and performing poems.

MATHS

Children will be:

- identifying 2D and 3D shapes.
- counting in 10s.
- identifying and creating patterns with shapes
- adding and subtracting within 10.
- keeping all the key skills and concepts 'on the boil' through a daily Maths Meeting.

SCIENCE

Children will be:

- identifying and naming a variety of common animals including, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals
- using scientific vocabulary.

COMPUTING

Children will be:

- learning to log on and off the chrome books
- taking photos and videos linked to our work on Instructions in English
- thinking about using the internet safely.

PSHE and P4C

Children will be:

- reflecting and think about our value, **Respect**, during assemblies and discussions in class
- exploring questions from our class text 'Handa's Surprise'
- in PSHE we will be celebrating how we are all different.

MUSIC

Children will be:

- learning two songs: 'Rhythm in The Way We Walk' (Reggae style) and 'Banana Rap' (Hip Hop style). They will listen and appraise other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games.
