Key Areas of Learning

ENGLISH

- Looking at the habitats of different animals especially those in our local environment.
- We will investigate all the different things that various animals need to have in order to survive in their different habitats. In addition to this, we will be looking at food chains and their importance.

PE

The children will continue to follow the Real PE scheme and will be focussing on large ball skills.

RE

The children will be learning to retell Bible stories that show kindness and how this makes Christians behave towards other people.

COMPUTING

The children will be using BeeBots to programme and debug algorithms.
