St. Nicholas' School Uniform Policy

St. Nicholas' School uniform is smart, comfortable and practical.

We ask parents to uphold our uniform policy. If you have any difficulty affording uniform at any time, please speak to the Headteacher or Home School Link Worker in confidence, as we may be able to help.

Items such as polo shirts with a collar, sweatshirts, caps, T-shirts and cardigans (all with the School Logo) are sold at Stevensons in Summertown. Other uniform items such as trousers and dresses are stocked in local shops and supermarkets. We also have a small amount of good quality second hand uniform in stock. Please ask for this at the office.

The parents of children in the nursery can decide whether their child will wear a uniform. We encourage Reception children to wear uniform. This is then upheld from Year 1.

Our uniform is non-gender specific

School Uniform:

Trousers, skirts, pinafores, short trousers – plain navy, grey or black (no denim jeans)

Shirts, blouses, T-shirts, polo shirts – white or red

Summer dresses – white/red patterns, white /blue patterns

Pullovers, sweatshirts, cardigans – school sweatshirt or cardigan - red

Footwear – sensible, comfortable footwear, flat shoes or trainers which do not rise above the ankles (no flip-flops or “high” heels)

For health and safety reasons, children are not allowed to wear jewellery to school except for small plain stud earrings. Children should have their hair tied up if it is longer than shoulder length.

Children need a letter from parents if they are unable to participate in PE. In the interest of safety long hair must be tied back for PE.

When the children go swimming they will require a costume, towel and swimming hat. Hats can be purchased from the school office for £1.00. All school clothing, school bags, PE kit and swimming gear MUST be labelled – one red sweatshirt looks very much like another!!

PE kit should be kept in a drawstring bag and consist of:

Black shorts and red or white T-shirt

Black elasticated plimsolls or trainers

Jogging trousers (for the colder weather)

If, for any reason a child is without a PE kit, then they will be expected to wear a kit provided by the school. *(During the time of Covid, we request that children come to school in their PE kit which they will keep on all day)*

Jewellery:

Please do not allow children to wear jewellery to school. This includes rings and earrings. Plain studs are accepted for pierced ears, but not encouraged. They must be removed for days when your child participates in PE/SWIMMING activities, including dance, games and gymnastics lessons. If your child has recently pierced ears, please tape them before coming to school. If your child comes for a lesson wearing large earrings, they will be asked to remove them for the lesson. Teachers cannot remove earrings.

School Bags:

As there is limited space in the cloakrooms please keep bags to a sensible size as large bags make it difficult to hang both coats and bags on the same peg.
