Key Areas of learning

As **Scientists**, we will identify and name parts of the body and perform simple tests and record data. As **Artists and Designers**, we will focus on a project based on faces. We will create self-portraits in different media, sculpt faces out of clay and make more detailed studies of our eyes. We will also look at and discuss portraits painted by a range of famous artists.

English

Children will be:

- Retelling the story of The Gruffalo
- Writing sentences based on The Gruffalo
- Writing labels, captions and lists as well as instructions
- Recapping Set 1 and 2 sounds in phonics
- Reciting counting poems and number rhymes

Maths

Children will be:

- Learning to count in 2s
- Counting up to 10 and back
- Finding one more and one less
- Adding and subtracting within 10
- learning about 2D shapes and patterns
- keeping all the key skills and concepts 'on the boil' through a daily Maths Meeting

Science

Children will be:

- identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the human body and say which part is associated with which sense.
- performing simple tests, gathering and recording data
- using their observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.

Computing

Children will be:

- using Beebots to give and follow simple instructions
- develop and record sequences of instructions as an algorithm
- starting to debug simple programmes

PSHCE and P4C

Children will be:

- reflecting and think about our value during assemblies and discussions in class
- exploring questions from our class text 'The Gruffalo
- discussing what it feels like to 'Being Me in my World'

Music

Children will be:

- given the opportunity to listen to different types of music, including classical
- learning to recognise instruments by sound
- to understand pitch, tempo and dynamics
- to clap and rap to simple rhythms
- to copy and improvise simple melodies

PE

Children will be:

- developing the skills of static balance and coordination through a range of activities and games

RE

Children will be:

- learning the Creation Story and thinking about how to look after the world.
